

POLICY

PRIVATE ROADS

It is the policy of the Board of County Road Commissioners of the County of Kalamazoo to recommend to each township Board of Trustees to develop and adopt ordinances or polices for private roads that require layout and design standards including right of way width and construction specifics such as drainage, sub-base, base, surface course applications and road signs to be equal to or greater than those as set forth by the policies of this Board.

It is further the policy of the Board that every township that allows private roads require by ordinance or policy a standard stop sign as a traffic control device at each location where the private road connects to the public road system.
